DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Successfully complete the following freshman/sophomore coursework at a regionally accredited school* with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA:

- 6 hours of English composition
- 6-8 hours of natural science with corresponding labs
- 6 hours of humanities (history, foreign language, philosophy, religion, classics, African American studies)
- 3 hours of fine arts (art, music, theatre, dance)
- 3 hours of social or behavioral science (psychology, sociology, political science, journalism, geography, anthropology
- 6 hours of literature or foreign language (same language)

- Calculus for Business, Economics, and Accountancy I ("C" or better)
- Calculus for Business, Economics, and Accountancy II
- Introduction to Accounting Principles I (with "B" or better)
- Introduction to Accounting Principles II (with "B" or better)
- Principles of Microeconomics (with "C" or better)
- Principles of Macroeconomics (with "C" or better)
- Introduction to Linear Programming
- Legal Environment of Business
- Business Communication (or Fundamentals of Public Speaking)
- Economic Statistics I (with "C" or better)

* All courses must be approved for transfer equivalency. A student failing to meet the 2.5 GPA requirement may appeal for an exception but should be able to cite strong evidence of his or her potential for successfully completing the program. Contact a UM-DeSoto advisor for more information.

Accountancy students may apply no more than 62 community college credit hours to this degree.
