English- 9 hours , ENG 1113, 1123 English Composition I, II  Choose one literature
Mathematics- 6 hours  MAT 2323 Elementary Statistics or BAD 2323 Business Statistics  MAT 1313 College Algebra or more advanced math
Lab Science- 8 hours  BIO 1114 with lab, BIO 1134 with lab, or BIO 2514 with lab  (Principles of Biology I, General Biology I, or Anatomy and Physiology I)  Choose a second lab science (Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Physics, or Astronomy)  (If BIO 1114 is chosen for first science, BIO 1154 will not work, and vice- versa. BIO 1613 Nutrition will not satisfy this requirement.
Social/ Behavioral Science- 6 hours  PSY 1513 General Psychology  SOC 2113 Introduction to Sociology
Fine Art- 3 hours  Choose any 3- hour Art, Music, Dance, or Theatre course.
Additional Fine Art or Humanities- 3 hours  Choose any two courses in HST, Literature, MFL, PHI, REL or FINE ART not taken above.
