## Application and Admission:

Applicants are encouraged to apply for admission online at [www.olemiss.edu/grenada](http://www.olemiss.edu/grenada). If you prefer a paper application, a printable form is available on the website or at the UM-Grenada office. Mississippi residents must pay a non-refundable \$50 application fee.

Applicants for admission (undergraduate or graduate) are advised to submit the application for admission well in advance of the period in which enrollment is sought. Mail official transcripts from all prior colleges to the admissions office in Oxford. Applicants applying for the spring can find application deadlines on the academic calendar at [www.olemiss.edu/depts/registrar/acal.html](http://www.olemiss.edu/depts/registrar/acal.html). Late application may require the applicant to register after classes begin and pay associated late registration fees. (See *academic calendar* for details.)

All regional students **MUST** be admitted to The University of Mississippi **before** they will be allowed to register for courses.

## Immunization Requirement:

All applicants born after January 1, 1957, must submit proof of two immunizations for measles and one for rubella prior to registration. The medical history and certificate of compliance forms are available at the UM-Grenada office and at [www.olemiss.edu/grenada](http://www.olemiss.edu/grenada).

Registration is accomplished via **myOleMiss**. Students register for classes and make schedule adjustments using their Web ID. New students may contact the office for instructions and assistance.

## Parking Decal:

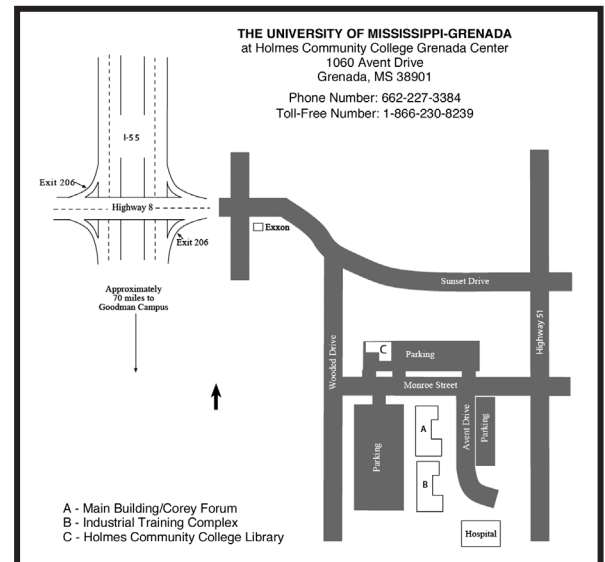

## 2025 Spring Academic Calendar

<b>Oct. 7-Nov. 4</b>	Academic Advising.
<b>Oct. 28-Nov. 11</b>	Priority Registration.
<b>Oct. 28-Nov. 30</b>	Phase 1 Registration period.
<b>November 8</b>	Application for first-time enrollment should be submitted no later than this date.
<b>December 1</b>	\$50 registration fee assessed this date. Phase 2 registration.
<b>January 20</b>	Martin Luther King, Jr. Holiday.
<b>January 20</b>	Last day to officially cancel registration and avoid responsibility for payment of tuition and fees.
<b>January 21</b>	Classes begin; registration fee (\$100) assessed this date; 100% refund (less 5% of fees or \$100, whichever is less) on withdrawals through February 3. Phase 3 registration.
<b>January 27</b>	Students may add courses on a space available basis through this date.
<b>February 3</b>	Last day to register or add courses (between January 28 and February 3 may add only with instructor's approval.) Refund period ends.
<b>February 4</b>	\$10 fee assessed per drop or add.
<b>February 10</b>	Mandatory drop date for non-attendance.
<b>March 7</b>	Deadline for course withdrawals (no refund); refund period ended February 3.
<b>March 8-16</b>	Spring Break.
<b>April 18</b>	Good Friday.
<b>May 2</b>	Classes end.
<b>May 5-9</b>	Final examinations.
<b>May 10</b>	Commencement.
