- Special Collections at UM

Who should go?

Open to students in all majors. Designed for students interested in: The South, the second World War, local & public history, museums. Ideal for students majoring or minoring in: History, Southern Studies, Museum Studies, Military Science, & Sociology. No prerequisites.

Prior to Departure

Meet with your Ole Miss instructor and fellow classmates on the Oxford campus May 12-16, 2025, for an overview of the course and an introduction to course topics.

During Travel

Travel dates are May 18-22, 2025. Depart with your instructors and classmates from Oxford, where you'll ride round-trip to New Orleans. Your instructors will share exact meeting times and locations before travel and will be available to you leading up to the course through Blackboard. Study USA arranges any ground transportation required during the travel dates. Study USA also arranges and books lodging in double occupancy hotel rooms.

Costs

\$1,700 Plus Tuition. The program fee includes shuttle/ van transportation to and from destination, lodging/ accommodation during travel, select group meals, museum admission, and entrance fees to parks & attractions. Not included in program fee is tuition, most meals at travel site, and personal spending money.

Once accepted to a program, the student accepts financial responsibility for Study USA program fees and tuition and must adhere to the application and withdrawal policy.
