Students will:

- Visit Johns Hopkins University, one of the leading medical institutions in the world.
- Explore Howard University, a historically Black university founded in the 1800s.
- Tour the iconic White House.
- Experience the National Museum of African American History and Culture.
- Learn at the National Institutes of Health (NIH).
- Walk the historic grounds of the prestigious Georgetown University.

Prior to Departure

Meet with your Ole Miss instructor and fellow classmates on the Oxford campus in April (TBD) for an introduction to the course and other students.

During Travel

Students make their own travel arrangements to and from the destination. Study USA will arrange all necessary ground transportation during your travel dates, starting

from your arrival. Study USA also books and provides double-occupancy rooms. Your instructor will provide exact meeting dates and location during orientation. Students may have their airfare billed to their bursar account. You'll receive details upon course enrollment.

Who should go?

Open to students in all majors. May interest students exploring careers in healthcare professions and those wishing to explore historical contributions of various ethnic backgrounds. Ideal for students interested in advancing their knowledge of how minority contributions are essential to American healthcare, both in terms of their vast number and their significant impact. No prerequisites.

Costs

\$1,250 plus tuition. The program fee includes local transportation during course, lodging/accommodation during travel, select group meals, museum admission, and group tours listed on the itinerary. Not included is tuition, airfare to and from destination, most meals at travel site, and personal spending money.

Once accepted to a program, the student accepts financial responsibility for Study USA program fees and tuition and must adhere to the application and withdrawal policy.

Itinerary subject to change. Students should wait to make travel arrangements until after confirming dates and times with instructors
