- Hear from state policy makers and decision-makers who shape Mississippi's education policies.
- Learn from national experts as you listen to representatives from national higher education organizations who develop proposed policies for legislators.
- Connect with high-level federal policy makers in Washington, D.C.
- Meet with national organizations based in D.C. to gain insights into proposed policies.
- Present proposed policy to stakeholders at the end of the course.
- Explore D.C.: Take advantage of the opportunity to visit key landmarks, including the Capitol and the Supreme Court.

## Location and Travel

## Costs

\$1,250 Plus Tuition. The program fee includes local transportation during course, lodging/Accommodation during travel, and select meals at travel site. Not included in program fee is tuition, airfare to and from destination, most meals at travel site, and personal spending money.
