## Students will:

- Meeting with Congressional staff members who work on the committees that draft environmental legislation.
- Discussing animal welfare and animal rights with representatives of **People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals**.
- Exploring environmental justice and environmental racism with a site visit to the **Center for Health, Environment, and Justice**.
- Visiting think tanks such as the **Aspen Institute** to discuss technology, economics, and the environment.
- Going to Annapolis, Maryland for a site visit at the **Chesapeake Bay Foundation** to see a real case of ecological crisis management.

## Prior to Departure

Meet with your Ole Miss instructor and fellow classmates on the Oxford campus December 8, 2025 for an introduction to the course.

## During Travel

Travel dates are January 11-17, 2026. Students make their own travel arrangements to and from the destination. Group transportation via metro will be provided. Students will stay in shared accommodations at a hotel on Capitol Hill, offering a convenient base for your stay. Your instructor will share exact meeting times and locations before travel. Study USA students may have their airfare billed to their bursar account. You'll receive details upon course enrollment.

## Who should go?

Open to students in all majors. May interest students in Philosophy, Political Science, Public Policy Leadership, Environmental Studies, and International Studies. No prerequisites.

## Costs

\$1,850 plus tuition. The program fee includes local transportation during course, lodging/accommodation during travel, select group meals, and daily activities listed in itinerary. Not included is tuition, airfare to and from destination, most meals at travel site, and personal spending money.

Once accepted to a program, the student accepts financial responsibility for Study USA program fees and tuition and must adhere to the application and withdrawal policy.
