- **EDUC 555 students:** Develop a research proposal based on one or more symposia at the conference.

## During Travel

Students make their own arrangements to travel to and from D.C. Double occupancy hotel rooms will be provided in conference hotels, offering a convenient base for your stay.

Your instructor will share exact meeting times and locations during pre-departure meetings and will be available to you leading up to the course through Blackboard. Students may have their airfare billed to their bursar account. You'll receive details upon course enrollment.

## Who should go?

Open to students in all majors. May interest students exploring careers in Applied Behavior Analysis. Ideal for students majoring or minoring in Psychology (with Behavior Analysis emphasis), Special Education, Communicative Sciences and Disorders, and Graduate students interested in becoming Board Certified Behavior Analysts. No prerequisites.

## Costs

\$1,100 plus tuition. The program fee includes local transportation during course, lodging/accommodation during travel, select group meals, and conference registration fee. Not included is tuition, airfare to and from destination, and personal spending money.

Once accepted to a program, the student accepts financial responsibility for Study USA program fees and tuition and must adhere to the application and withdrawal policy.
